

Distribution of Lessons

The charts below show the distribution of lessons between subjects for each year group. Each lesson is 50 minutes long and the school week is comprised of 30 lessons. Where fractions of a lesson are shown, this indicates those subjects are not taught every week, for example "Citizenship 0.5" reflects one Citizenship lesson every fortnight.

Please note:

We may adjust timetables for some Students in all years to best meet their individual needs.

In Years 10 and 11:

- "Option 1" and "Option 2" refer to GCSE subjects selected by each Student.
- The distribution of lessons will be different for Students who opt for off-site vocational courses. In this case the timetables will be adjusted to suit individual Students.
- PSHE and RE are delivered in part through termly themed "whole day" activities.
