



## Heathside Year 7 Catch-up Premium report 2014-2015

In 2014-2015 Heathside School was allocated £4,500 for the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium. This funding aims to help students who entered Year 7 with SATs scores of below Level 4 in Reading and/or Maths to 'catch up' to their peers. The table below summarises the funding received and how it was used. 9 students were allocated this funding in 2014-15. A number of other students who were just above this Threshold also received support.
